Core learning task

This week **all groups** will complete the same maths tasks.

This week you are learning about time. In school we have learned about daily routines when using our timetable. When doing our daily calendar we were learning about days of the week, dates and months of the year.

Once you have learned the days of the week and months of the year, answer the following questions. You can either say the answers aloud or write the answers down.

- If today is Tuesday, what day was it yesterday?
- If tomorrow is Saturday, what day is it today?
- If yesterday was Wednesday, what day is it today?
- What day comes before Monday?
- What day comes after Thursday?
- How many days are in a week?

- What month comes after September?
- What month comes before April?
- What month are we in now?
- What month comes at the start of the year?
- What month comes at the end of the year?
- How many months are in a year?

If you would like you can make your own your own calendar like we have in school. Remember to include the days of the week, the date, the months of the year.
